

National Board of Public Health Examiners (NBPHE) *Ad-Hoc* Subcommittee to MOC
August 2009

The NBPHE selected seven members of the Charter Class of CPH to serve on an *ad-hoc* subcommittee to advise the NBPHE's Maintenance of Certification committee on communications related to continuing education for CPH professionals.

These volunteers were chosen from more than 50 applicants. They are representative of the spectrum of the public health profession. From seven states and having backgrounds that include psychology, safety/injury-prevention, health education, international development, and maternal/child health, they include five individuals with Masters-level training and two with Doctoral-level preparation. Three volunteers are early in their public health careers while four are established public health professionals. The volunteers bring experience from a variety of capacities including research, counseling, academia and management, and are connected with a range of local, regional, national, and international agencies and institutions.

Central to the committee's mandate, these individuals have other active credentials or licensures (including Certified Health Education Specialist, Fellow of the American College of Healthcare Executives, American Council on Exercise Credentials, Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist, and Licensed Professional Counselor). These members also have experience in providing or administering continuing education or certification for fire safety officers, physician's assistants, physicians, nurses, pharmacists, radiologic technologists, and veterinarians. With these backgrounds, the committee members bring valuable first-hand experience to the NBPHE as it continues to refine Maintenance of Certification issues for the emerging CPH credential.
